Guidelines:

1. 2-4 letters of support, in addition to the nominator's letter.
2. 3-5 letters of support from past and/or current students.
3. Nominating letter (maximum 6 single-spaced pages) should address each of the following:
  - **Teaching Ability:** What teaching and assessment techniques does this teacher employ? Is the course comprehensive, yet enjoyed by the students? What is the teaching philosophy?
  - **Inventiveness:** What new ideas are used? What new curriculum and support materials are produced? What new methods or devices are used?
  - **Initiative:** How are new situations handled? How are students of varying abilities accommodated?
  - **Cooperation:** How does the teacher cooperate in the total school program and in other academic areas?
  - **Community and youth activities:** How is the teacher involved in community and youth activities?
  - **Professional activities:** Publications, advising, program development.
  - **Summary:** as to the candidate's strengths and noteworthy accomplishments as they relate to the nomination for the teaching award.
4. Nominee should be involved in the nomination by supplying:
  - a. A one-page teaching philosophy
  - b. A 2-page CV (similar to an NSF biographical sketch)
  - c. Examples of teaching materials or methods, and evidence of teaching effectiveness and improved student learning (for example, descriptions of lessons or exercises, summaries of numerical and/or written student comments from teaching evaluations, peer teaching evaluations; **limit of 10 pages**).
